Over 1,000 IFMA 2014 World Workplace attendees participated in CORT's annual survey, asking facility managers about the office space they manage and the priorities for not only their department, but those of their overall organization.


What we found:

- 97% of respondents said that employee productivity is very important or plays a role when evaluating office furniture needs.
- 2. With the popularity of open, less defined office spaces, the majority of respondents' workplaces were not, with 77% being traditional or mixed/other.

- Overall (open, closed and other) you listed your priorities as follows:
 - *Respondents could choose multiple
- Employee productivity and well-being: 71%
- Flexibility to adapt to change in requirements: 60%
- Business Continuity: 45%
- Impression and Appearance (of the office): 40%
- Profitability: 33%
- Other: 4% (included availability, comfort and sustainability)
