RENTAL MARKET TRENDS

IN THE LAST YEAR, BOTH THE NASHVILLE AND NYC RENTAL MARKETS ARE SEEING AN INCREASE IN THEIR RATES WITH NASHVILLE RENT INCREASING BY 18% WHILE THE NYC RENT RATES HAVE SHOWN A 13% INCREASE.

IN THE LAST MONTH, NYC IS SEEING RENT RATES TRENDING DOWNWARDS, WHEREAS NASHVILLE IS SEEING RENT RATES INCREASING.

How do rental costs in Nashville compare to NYC?



As of January 7, 2023, the average rent for a 1-bedroom apartment in Nashville, TN is \$1,798. This is an 18% increase compared to the previous year.



While in New York, as of December 31, 2022, the average rent for a 1bedroom apartment is \$3,725. This is a 13% increase compared to the previous year.

In Nashville, over the last month,

- \$1,684. One bedroom: Increased by 3%
